## *Summer School – French program prior to university study*

### Course description

2-week program from August 18 to 29, 2025 (41 hours of class in all)

### LEVELS A1, A2, and B1

#### **Language study** (18 hours)

**A1, A2, B1**

The purpose of this course is to discover the basic structures of spoken and written language through activities in **oral comprehension, oral expression, written comprehension, and written expression.**

#### **Phonetics** (9 hours)

**A1, A2, B1**

The phonetics course is based on activities in correct phonetics, the link between sounds and writing, and repeating dialogues and/or grammatical exercises on structures studied in the language study course.

#### **Civilisation** (14 hours)

**A1, A2, B1**

The purpose of this course is to help students with a few everyday situations and raise their awareness of what daily and cultural life in France is like. The course emphasises activities in all oral and written production, drawing on the two-week cultural programme.

## LEVELS B2, C1 and C2

### **Language study** (18 hours)

*B2, C1, C2*

The purpose of this course is to build on knowledge of spoken and written language through activities in **oral comprehension, oral expression, written comprehension, and written expression.**

### **Phonetics** (9 hours)

*B2, C1, C2*

The language lab course is based on activities in correct phonetics, the link between sounds and writing, and repeating dialogues and/or grammatical exercises on structures studied in the language study course.

### **French for university purposes** (14 hours)

*B2, C1, C2*

The objective of this course is to familiarise students with university life in France and Rennes and to show them how to conduct their studies in a French university. It also seeks to equip them with the methodological skills needed to follow lessons at university.
